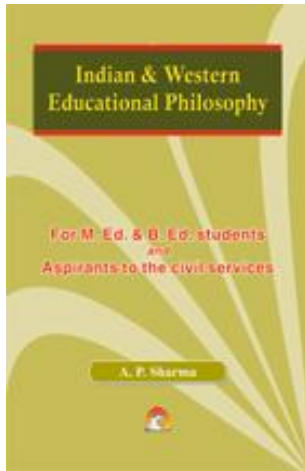




Indian & Western Educational Philosophy
